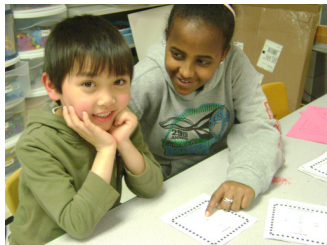
Support for Chinese Adults 55+
